



NEVADA DIVISION OF WATER RESOURCES REOPENING GUIDELINES

In accordance with Governor Sisolak's guidance to reopen all state buildings to in-person business, NDCNR offices are now open to public foot traffic.

Please note that some restricted access will be in place during your visit. Health and safety guidelines will be in place in accordance with the CDC, State of Nevada and DCNR. Individuals who are NOT fully vaccinated for COVID are required to socially distance and wear a face covering.

Important information for visitors to the Division of Water Resources:

- Appointments are strongly encouraged for anyone needing to meet with staff or review files. Visitors to the NDWR Carson City office will be limited to 3 appointments at any one time. Appointments will provide certainty as to the ability to meet with staff or review files.
- Appointments must be made by calling our office at (775) 684-2800.
- When you arrive, please call the office and a staff member will meet you at the door and escort you upstairs. You will be asked to sign in and sign out upon your arrival/departure.
- No appointment is needed for dropping off documents, making filings or paying fees, walk-ins will be allowed for these purposes.
- Walk-ins for reviewing documents and files or meeting with staff will only be accommodated if space allows.
- When setting up an appointment please make sure that the time you requested is sufficient to conduct your business. If another's appointment follows yours, you will be asked to leave and reschedule for a later time.
